Learn to skate or build on the skills you already have! Thomas Creek's Learn to Skate program provides instruction to skaters from ages 4 to adult, beginner through advanced. Our instructors are top of the line. Since starting in 1989 we have grown to become the largest Learn to Skate program in the area.

The **United States Figure Skating Association (USFSA)** Basic Skills program is designed to lead you through progressive levels of skating ability to achieve consistently excellent results.

- Students are grouped by level and ability.
- Snowplow Sam and Basic 1 - 8 include a 20- minute group lesson.
- The remainder of time is available for those enrolled to use as uninstructed practice time.
- Testing is on the last day of each session.
- Our classes are held on dedicated ice for Learn to Skate participants only.
- USFSA enrollment is included.

She is a 7 time Adult National competitor. Leanne played defense for the Women's Ice Hockey team at RIT. She is a member of the USFSA and the Professional Skaters Association.

Learn To Skate Costs and Descriptions

Snowplow Sam: For ages 4 - 6. Designed to help the preschooler develop preliminary coordination and strength to maneuver and be comfortable on the ice. Safety helmets are strongly recommended. Adults must be in attendance during session but are not allowed on the ice. Class includes a 20-minute group lesson. Remainder of the time is for practice.

Mommy & Me: Join your preschool child and learn to skate with them. Only available during Tuesday and Friday classes.
